Furthermore, I think that your show was dangerous too. We were really frightened when one of lions moved from the ring towards the audience.

Finally, after the circus program, we were hungry. But the queue for drinks was extremely long and only slowly moving. There were thousands of people on the show, but only one or two brigade-workers served drinks for these crowds. And what really made me angry was the awfully muddy field, which we had to cross, when we went from Grand Marquee home. When I came home, it was necessary to throw my shoes to the bin.
