This museum is a cavernous hall filled with gleaming old planes and cars. The private

railway carriage of Austro-Hungarian Archduke Franz Ferdinand can be found on the main

floor. The balconies are stuffed with **motorcycles** and **bicycles**. Nearby there is also a realistic

reconstruction coal mine, a great selection of cameras and a fascinating exhibition on

timekeeping technology throughout the ages.

The collection of tape recorders shows the development of magnetic recording of sound

from the oldest wire phones to the most modern tape recorders of both Czechoslovak and

foreign provenance. You will obtain a new dimension of knowledge how these branches were

evolving for example: sugar, brewing, distilling, milling and other fields of **food industry**.

How to get there - the nearest connection by the underground is the station Hradcanska on

the line A or Vltavska on the line C. From these underground stations should be used trams

no.1, 8, 15, 25 or 26 to the tram stop Letenske namesti.

**Opening hours** are from 9:00 to 18:00.

**Admission** is Kc70 for adults; Kc30 for students and children up to 18 years.
